From the south exit Lander and turn right on Glenwood at the Chevron Station, from the north exit Lander and turn left at the light going under the freeway and then turn right on Glenwood at the Chevron Station. **Continue** to the end of Glenwood and turn left onto Golf, it becomes South First St. after it curves to the left. The field will be on the left after the veterinary
It is our goal to have a fun trial for you and especially for your dog, so if you can help, please do so.



We are pleased to let you know that we have updated some equipment. We now have our chutes, barrels, dogwalk, tables, teeter and Aframes coated with rubber granules.

Check-in - the dog's permanent registration card shall be shown. If the owner cannot show the card, the dog must be measured, and your dog may need to move to a higher jump height for that trial. Any dog entered in a 24" jump height or is a 24" veteran does not need to be measured except to measure for a permanent card. A general exhibitors' briefing will be given following measuring and check-in, prior trial starting. Exhibitors not attending the general briefing will still be subject to the terms and conditions set forth in such a briefing. Neither the judge(s) nor the host club is required to provide details of the general briefing once it has been given.

Final Move-Up Date has been changed to October 10th. This will cover the time of our closing date of 10-5 to the Monday after the WAG CPE. Also there will be move-ups from Saturday for Sunday at our trial.
